The new school building opened in October of 2011 and, in addition to classrooms, includes a music room, tutoring room, communication room, library, science lab, full-sized gymnasium with locker rooms, kitchen, laundry room, teachers' prep room, administration offices, and a commons area. The school spans over 30,000 square feet and sits on a hill that overlooks the Cascade Mountains and valley wetlands.
